

To say this past year was a challenge would be an understatement! Through the ups and downs, your support has propelled us into a new year. We receive calls and emails weekly from people from all over the country seeking clothing assistance. It is humbling to hear their stories and sad to know not every community or even every state has a basic needs clothing resource available.

The work we are doing at the Community Clothes Closet is unique and allows our clients to shop for free saving their limited income for other basic needs like shelter, food and medical care. This past year we saw many families who were struggling to meet their basic needs and as our client numbers continue to rise, we know the **NEED** will be even greater in the coming weeks and months.

We recently worked with a family that moved to the Hilbert area from out of state. They were overwhelmed and moved to tears when learning about our services and the community support behind our mission. They have been struggling for a few months since losing their jobs as a result of COVID and having a hard time making ends meet. The CCC assisted them with warm clothing and made sure their children had the necessary snow pants and boots to participate in school recess with their peers. Now that they have their basic need of clothing met, they can focus on job hunting and getting their family back on the road to self-sufficiency.

Financial gifts support our daily operations and programming that provide new back to school clothing, warm pajamas for our youngsters, baby kits for newborns and career clothing for clients interviewing and re-entering the workforce.

COOL FOR SCHOOL - UPDATE

Our Cool for School event took place this past August – a time when we still weren't sure if in-person school would happen or not. In an effort to ensure children still received the items they needed, a parent from each family was able to shop for their children with safely distanced stations. Each child received new clothing, socks, underwear and a Rogan's Shoes gift certificate for gym shoes. Through this program we were able to serve over 280 students in our community! In the last 5 years, we've provided more than 3,200 students with over 42,000 new items to start their school year off on the right foot.

EVERYTHING COUNTS

Have you ever wondered what happens to clothing we receive that we can't use because of condition issues? We receive close to one million donated items every year and there are times when items come to us with holes, tears, stains or other condition issues. We are proud to say we try our hardest to keep as many things out of the landfill as possible. The CCC repurposes clothing for craft projects and works with a recycling partner who sends clothing overseas to third world countries and recycles overworn clothing into carpet fiber, wall insulation and upholstery. Buttons and zippers are also stripped off for reuse. In the end, very little goes into the landfill!

SPARKLE AND SHINE VIRTUAL POP-UP



A couple of years ago we launched our Community Clothes Closet Pop-Up Shops. The Pop-Up Shops provide us opportunities to sell high end items for a fraction of the price to a charity-minded customer bargain shopper. It generates revenue for the Community Clothes Closet without impacting our mission of providing free clothing to people in need.

We've been able to "pop-up" at Mile of Music, OctoberFest, small craft fairs and even a women's real estate meeting. This year, because of COVID, we had to get creative. We held our first ever virtual Pop-Up through our Facebook page in December. The *Sparkle and Shine Virtual Pop-Up* offered our shoppers new and gently used items for an affordable price with all proceeds coming back to the CCC to support the programs and services we offer for our clients free of charge. When you shop at our pop-ups you're ensuring the CCC is able to continue its mission of providing free clothing to children, women and men in need right here in our community.
